## Members

### Indian association

World Archery has conditionally lifted the suspension of the Archery Association of India following elections in New Delhi on 18 January. The decision was made by executive board postal vote. Indian archers are allowed to compete in World Archery events as of Thursday 23 January 2020. They had been banned from international competition for five months.

### Development agent

Cushla Matheson started in the role of World Archery's development agent in Oceania on 6 January 2020, replacing Robert Turner who held the position since February 2018. Turner now works with Archery Australia's high-performance programme. Matheson, 35, is a sports manager who has experience in team leadership, event organisation, international relations and development. She is now responsible for the development of World Archery's member associations in Oceania, with a focus on good governance, performance programmes and administration.

### School sport

The executive committee of the International School Sport Federation confirmed the appointment of Rifaat Chabouk as coordinator of its technical commission for archery during its meeting held in November 2019. His appointment will run until 2022. Rifaat is currently the secretary general of the Real Federacion Espanola de Tiro con Arco, the governing body of archery in Spain. The next ISF Gymnasiade School Summer Games will be held in Jinjiang, China on 17 to 24 October 2020 and include individual, team and mixed team archery events.



## Broadcasting

### NBC Olympic Channel

NBC will broadcast the Indoor Archery World Series Finals live from Las Vegas on its Olympic Channel on cable for the first time. The event takes place on Saturday 8 February 2020 and is the culmination of a six-event international tour that started in Macau in November 2019. This does mean that the live online stream will not be available to view in the USA.

**Recognition award**

Carole Hicks, World Archery para committee’s outgoing chairperson received a World Archery recognition award for incredible services and contribution to the discipline of para archery. The medal was presented by Duane Kale on behalf of World Archery during an informal ceremony on 23 December 2019 in Wellington, New Zealand.



**Life membership**

Susanne Womersley has been awarded Life Membership of Archery Victoria during its Annual General Meeting on 23 January 2020, the highest honour the organisation may award. This completes a life membership treble for Susanne with Archery Australia (2006), Geelong Archers (2016) and Archery Victoria (2019/2020). Susanne is a member of World Archery’s technical committee, the president of World Archery Oceania, and an international judge.



**Torchbearer**

Swiss archer Nathalie Dielen, who competed at the Olympics in 2008 and 2012, carried the torch for the 2020 Winter Youth Olympic Games on the last day of its tour in the host city of Lausanne. The flame was lit on 17 September in Athens before embarking on a journey through Switzerland’s 26 cantons. Dielen took the torch during a segment in the old city. Four of World Archery’s office staff are also volunteering at the Games.

**World #1**

The USA finishes 2019 with three archers in the number one spots in the world rankings as Brady Ellison, Braden Gellenthien and Alexis Ruiz sit top alongside Korea’s Kang Chae Young. All four are new names compared to the end-of-year list from 31 December 2018. The World Archery rankings are updated every two weeks and after major international events to provide an up-to-date rating of the world’s best archers. The last world ranking list of 2019 was issued on 31 December.

The wins pushed Barnes and Pearce to the top spots in the Indoor Archery World Series elite rankings. The 2020 Sydney Indoor Archery Festival is the first event on the Indoor Archery World Series to be held in the Southern Hemisphere. It came at a testing time for the country, which is dealing with bushfires.

It is the second year in a row that Gellenthien has won the compound men's event in France. The tournament was the penultimate stage of the Indoor World Series. The last is the Vegas Shoot.

### Dakar 2022

The International Olympic Committee executive board approved the period of 22 October to 9 November 2022 for the fourth edition of the Dakar 2022 Youth Olympic Games. It will be the first Olympic event on the African continent. The board also approved the request from the organising committee to add baseball5 and wushu to the sports programme. Archery was already confirmed.



## Tokyo 2020

### Rule 50

There are restrictions on the type, size and amount of logos on equipment used at the Olympic Games. Rule 50 is part of the Olympic Charter and is a guide to the restriction of advertising in competition venues at the Olympic Games. World Archery and the International Olympic Committee publish a set of guidelines on the permitted sizes of logos on archery equipment. These archery-specific guidelines are in addition to the general guidelines for Rule 50.

### National trials

Spain's Olympic trials have seen the field cut to eight-athlete recurve men's and recurve women's squads after the second of three selection events that finished on 19 December 2019. Miguel Alvarino Garcia leads the men's ranking and Alicia Marin is top of the women. The third and final phase of the trials will conclude on Sunday 23 February. Spanish archers currently hold one spot for Tokyo.

Tang Chih-Chun, Wei Chun-Heng, Deng Yu-Cheng, Lin Chia-En and Tan Ya-Ting will join reigning World Archery Champion Lei Chien-Ying as Chinese Taipei's archery team at the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games. The women are the defending Olympic team bronze medallists. Taipei was one of four nations to secure the full six-athlete quota at last year's world championships alongside Korea, China and Great Britain.

Alejandra Valencia, who finished fourth in the recurve women's competition at the Rio 2016 Olympic Games, has been named to the Mexican team for Tokyo 2020 following the conclusion of national trials in the nation's capital. She won Mexico's only archery place so far in the secondary tournament at the last world championships. According to the selection procedure, if she finished in the top three of the trials, she would also automatically fulfil that spot at the Games.
