World Archery Oceania

Patsy Vercoe was re-elected secretary general and **Didier Gras** elected vice president of World Archery Oceania on 30 April for a second full-term until 2026.

Cuba

Tamara Jimenez and **Vladimir Dominguez Ambros** were re-elected as president and secretary general of the Cuban archery federation for terms until 2026.

DPR Korea

Following former president **Kim Jin Guk** retirement, **Hong Kyong Sik** was elected as president of the DPR Korea archery association on 14 March for a term until 2027.
