In the period since the 2013 World Archery Congress, three matters have been referred to the Board of Justice and Ethics for consideration. Two of the references were from the President of World Archery and one was from the Executive Board of World Archery.

All references were dealt with in accordance with the procedure set out in Appendix 3 to the Constitution of World Archery.

The decision of the Board of Justice and Ethics in each matter was unanimous and, in accordance with the requirements of Appendix 3, took the form of a recommendation to the World Archery Executive Board. Each decision was ratified and implemented by the Executive Board.

All the members of the Board of Justice and Ethics gave prompt and well considered input into the formulation of the Board's decisions. I take this opportunity to place on record my appreciation of this participation, which has enabled the Board to meet the important objective of dealing promptly with matters before it.

There are no active matters currently under consideration by the Board.

It is a matter of particular satisfaction to know that the experience and knowledge of our Honorary Chairman, Francesco Gnechi-Ruscione, is available to the Board in an appropriate case. This has not occurred, but knowledge of the existence of that wisdom is of much value in the discharge of our role.
