My first priority as a committee member would be to increase accessibility of para archers to the sport. I understand the physical disability aspect of an archer as well as the rules of what and what is not allowed for equipment. During Classification, if an Archer needs to adjust their equipment so they will pass inspection, I am able to work with them so they can fully participate. My goal is to develop programs that can reach out to associations that are just developing in World Archery and increase their para participation.</p> <p>My second goal is to work on the education of the Judges and Classifiers on para athletes and their equipment. I have found that many Judges do not know what to look for on the classification card and how to accurately assess whether or not a piece of equipment is allowed. Classifiers can assist the newly classified archer on whether or not their equipment needs to be adjusted to pass equipment inspection. I am currently designing a Judge's training guide after providing education during an equipment inspection at a World Ranking Event.</p>
