	2.4.3 An athlete who has changed his nationality, or acquired a new nationality, <u>will need to notify World Archery of the change before he competes internationally representing their new country</u> and may not represent the National Tem of his new Member Association until one year after such a change or acquisition.					
7. Reason	In the current Rule Book, notification of World Archery about nationality change is not a requirement. World Archery needs to be notified of the change for it to amend its records going forward appropriately.
