7. Reason

In case you have a category with **5** participants as happened at the WAE European Master Games – Field in Rivoli 2019 (http://ianseo.net/Details.php?told=5926) in the divisions

- Recurve Women 40+
- Recurve Women 60+
- Compound Men 30+
- Compound Women 50+

you have the following situation:

Pool A	Pool B	Pool C	Pool D
3	5	4	6

- The athletes ranked 1 and 2 go to the semi-final automatically (Book 2/4.5.3.3.2 and Book 2/4.5.6.2.2).
- The "winner of Pool A" is the athlete ranked on the 3rd position.
- The "winner of Pool B" is the athlete ranked on the 5th position.
- The "winner of Pool C" is the athlete ranked on the 4th position.
- There is no "winner of Pool D" because there is no athlete ranked on the 6th position.

Now the archers ranked 3 and 5 shoot a match for one of the remaining spots in the semi-final, on the other hand the archer ranked on the 4th position is already in the semi-final.

This cannot be correct

- To be higher ranked (3rd place) is a disadvantage against the archer ranked 4th
- The archer ranked on 3rd place must get this advantage.
- Comparing to ¼-finals in the Match Play Chart of Target Archery where 3 shoots against 6 and 4 shoots against 5.

It must be

The <u>winner of Pool A</u> will <u>shoot against</u> the <u>winner of Pool D</u> and the <u>winner of Pool C</u> will <u>shoot against</u> the <u>winner of Pool B</u> for entry into the semi-finals.

Attached you can find a drawing of the brackets for the Pool Shoot-up system also showing the difference between the rules actual and after the change with this motion.
