Text of the motion (*)	<p>Article 2.1.1 is amended to read as follows:            2.1.1 Athletes, coaches and officials who wish to be part of their National Teams at events, which are recognised or controlled by World Archery, in one or more of the various disciplines recognised by World Archery, shall be affiliated with a Member Association and have a valid international license.            For National Tournaments, the affiliation with a Member Association is necessary.</p> <p>Marked version to show revisions from current Law:            Athletes, coaches and officials who wish to <del>participate in Championships, Games, International and National Tournaments</del> <b>be part of their National Teams at events</b>, which are recognised or controlled by World Archery <del>or a Member Association</del>, in one or more of the various disciplines recognised by World Archery, shall be affiliated with a Member Association and have a valid international license. <del>(until such time that the Executive Board adopts bylaws as to international license requirements, an athlete's, coaches' and official's membership in his Member Association shall constitute a valid international license.)</del>  <b>For National Tournaments, the affiliation with a Member Association is necessary.</b></p> <p><b>Related bylaw:</b>  <b>Article 2.1.1.1 to remain as it is. For clarity reasons, it is included in the motion:</b>  <i>Athletes, coaches and officials who wish to participate as part of a national team in Championships, World Cups or other events for which the registration is through the online entry system controlled by World Archery, in one or more of the various disciplines recognised by World Archery, shall be affiliated with a Member Association and have a valid international license.</i></p>

7. Reason	In between Congresses a bylaw with more detail regards for licenses was adopted and there in no longer need for reference to transitional procedure. Affiliation with Member Associations is necessary for multiple purposes – for example to make sure that athletes are held accountable in case of anti-doping or other violations; it also helps with keeping track of membership.
