6. Text of the motion (*)	Wheelchair Para classified athletes may stay on the shooting line throughout the match. They indicate that they have finished shooting by raising a hand above the head (see Chapter 21 - Para-Archery);
7. Reason	Even if they are not in a wheelchair, para classified athletes need more time than an able-bodied athlete either to leave and to come to the shooting line, or to load an arrow into his bow.  A para classified athlete should not be disadvantaged when shooting in an able-bodied team by staying on the shooting line. And an able-bodied team will not be advantage with a para classified athlete staying on the shooting line.
8. Relevant committee's feedback	Para Archery Committee: The Committee clearly supports it with no demand of amendment.
