However, just the new rules for Field Archery are presented and the rules for 3D have not been revised and adjusted in the Motion 15.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The adjusted rules for 3D follow the Field and 3D Committee ´s new rules for Field. • Therefore, the order of articles is also changed for readability reasons. |

With the exception of the comment “Both medal matches are shot on an additional four targets” the Field and 3D Committee agree with the amendment.

There is no requirement for this line as the finals matches are on the finals venue and the rule already requires the targets to be different to those on the individual.
