As soon as the Electoral Board has validated the eligibility the status will be updated, and the form will be published as part of the Congress documents. This form will be published without the personal data. Only in case insufficient valid candidatures are received a 2nd round will be opened after the 29 April 2023.

It is reminded: a person cannot be candidate for more than 2 positions. (If a candidate is candidate for 2 positions, then 2 forms must be completed)

- The president or secretary general of the member association, or Executive Board Member presenting the candidate (page 1)

Function in member association</p>	<p>I have volunteered with Archery GB since 1995 at several international events (European, World Cup, World Championships) held in the UK.</p> <p>Before being employed at Archery GB I started the National Series (a domestic version of the World Archery World Cup with a grand final event). This has become a benchmark series for other NGBs around the world to copy and have as an annual national event at home.</p> <p>I also created a similar level indoor tournament modeled from the Face-to-Face. The UK Back-to-Back started in 2010 as an elite level tournament for domestic and international archers to attend. The different format adds variety to the indoor circuit.</p> <p>Since being employed at Archery GB I have worked for years developing event formats to improve presentation and increase participation. Another current focus of my role is to develop the next generation of event organizers, this is done through shadowing schemes and mentoring opportunities.</p>
<p>10. Function in other sports organisation(s)</p>	<p>Archery GB is a member of UK Sport, the British government umbrella for all sports national governing bodies.</p> <p>Through my role with Archery GB and our shared site (Lilleshall National Sports Centre) with several other UK sports NGBs I am involved in a transfer of knowledge group for event best-practice and delivery models. In addition to this I am also part of another working group that includes many outdoor sports NGBs - we problem solve and share innovations between similar sports.</p>

As the event director for the UK I have always tried to improve our domestic tournaments. This includes changes such as target field layouts, events scoring and timing procedures, tournament operations and equipment (such as electronic PDA scoring introduced in 2014). For more major finals I am always driving increased media coverage and build a spectator following given the increase in social media importance in the past few years. This is what I plan to focus on in this role.

Having led several international events in the UK I have worked on innovative changes to schedules and format to try and improve the experience for both athletes and spectators whilst also driving media interest. Examples include introducing three days worth of finals content for the European Youth Championships to give extra broadcast sessions, exciting indoor format changes such as the Back-to-Back shoot down finals since 2021 and delivering a European Grand Prix to a World Cup schedule. These are examples of ideas that I can bring to the target committee.

Having been a part of the UK sport event managers sessions for years, I study other sports and learn how they bring their events to more people to deliver better stories and build attendance from new spectators. Other sports face the same challenges that Archery does on a world level and learning from other sports can help Archery continue to grow, and I look forward to bringing this to the role.
