



Qualification System for the Barranquilla 2018 Central American and Caribbean Games

CACSO has requested World Archery Americas to submit the Qualification System for the Central American and Caribbean Games to be held in Barranquilla, from July 20 to August 3, 2018.

As for 2014, 100 slots have been allocated to archery, with the following events:

Recurve Women Individual
Recurve Men Individual
Compound Women Individual
Compound Men Individual

Recurve Women Team
Recurve Men Team
Recurve Mixed Team
Compound Women Team
Compound Men Team
Compound Mixed Team

Taking the qualification system for Veracruz 2014 as the starting point, the slots have been distributed as follows:

<u>Individual Events</u>	<u>Slots for Veracruz</u>	<u>Slots for Barranquilla</u>
Recurve Women	24	24
Recurve Men	28	27
Compound Women	21 /finally 19	22
Compound Men	27	27

The number of recurve men positions is reduced by one because for Veracruz 2014 all archers who competed in the Qualifiers won places for their countries. The number of compound women is increased to 22, despite the fact that only 19 competed in Veracruz, because there were several more participants in the qualifiers.

There will be two **Qualification Tournaments**:

Tournament 1 – to be held between July and November 2017
Tournament 2 - to be held between March and April 2018

The dates and venues for the two qualifiers will be decided by the World Archery Americas General Assembly to be held in Costa Rica in May 2016.

The slots will be distributed as follows:

8 positions for the top individuals in Tournament 1 (excluding the teams qualified as such).
4 positions for the top individuals in Tournament 2

Recurve Women

3 positions for Colombia (host country)
12 positions for the top 4 teams in Tournament 1
6 positions for the top individuals in Tournament 1 (excluding the teams qualified as such).
3 positions for the top individuals in Tournament 2

Compound Men

3 positions for Colombia (host country)
12 positions for the top 4 teams in Tournament 1
8 positions for the top individuals in Tournament 1 (excluding the teams qualified as such).
4 positions for the top individuals in Tournament 2

Compound Women

3 positions for Colombia (host country)
12 positions for the top 4 teams in Tournament 1
4 positions for the top individuals in Tournament 1 (excluding the teams qualified as such).
3 positions for the top individuals in Tournament 2

Participation in the Qualifiers:

In the first qualifying tournament, each National Federation can enter up to 4 participants in each category, though only 3 can get positions for their country, either in the team round or by winning three individual positions.

In the second qualifier, those National Federations which have not won three positions in a category will be allowed to enter up to 4 archers in the qualifier in each of these categories. Archers who won positions in the first qualifier cannot compete in the second qualifier.

Qualifying to compete as a team

A country can compete in the team round of a category if it wins one of the team positions in the first qualifier or if three individual archers from this country win individual spots in the first and second qualifiers. A country may win up to three spots in each category in each of the two qualifiers.
