PRELIMINARY & FINAL REGISTRATION

All the registration process must be done using the World Archery Online Registration System (WAREOS): https://extranet.worldarchery.org. No entry forms will be accepted for registering for this event.

A maximum number of 3 athletes per Event (host country included) are allowed to be registered into each category of the event. All entries have to be done using WAREOS.

In order to use WAREOS, each MA Extranet Admin user or a multiple user who has specific privileges assigned within your member association need to long-in into the Extranet. Please note that your member association WAREOS' account is no longer available functionally.

Please pay attention to the stated deadlines. Teams will not be able to enter or update their data in WAREOS, after the deadlines, as the system will be blocked. If teams wish to make any changes to their Final Registration after the deadline, they need to contact Mr. Jae Kyung Lee Email: jklee@archery.org.

Final Entries processed after the deadline will result in a penalty fee of 50 Euros per athlete to be paid to the LOC upon arrival at the field.

Final registrations that differ by more than 3 athletes from the preliminary registration or have been submitted after the preliminary deadline will result in a penalty fee of 150 Euros to be paid to the LOC upon arrival at the field.

Any entries received fewer than 3 days before the Team Managers' meeting will be refused if no preliminary entry and/or final entry were made. This decision cannot be appealed by the teams and is fully compliant with the current World Archery rules, article 3.7.1.2. Entries received after the deadlines are subject to penalties as clearly stated in the rulebook and the invitation documents of World Cups and World Championships. A Member Association which has made final entries in WAREOS and does not participate will be invoiced for the number of entries in the system unless they have informed World Archery and the LOC in writing at least one week before the event that they are unable to attend.

Member Associations, which have penalty fees outstanding from 2014 will need to have paid these penalty fees before being eligible to enter and compete in The 3rd Asian Para Archery Championships & CQT 2020 Tokyo Paralympics in Bangkok, Thailand.

No rooms are specifically wheelchair accessible but doors are wide enough (approximately 28-30inches wide) to enter rooms. The bathrooms have shower boxes with a small step (approx. 2cm). The shower extension over the bath has a long lead and thus by using the provided special wheelchairs it should be reasonable for wheelchair users. There are no handrails by the toilet, bath or shower.

THAILAND

Located in Southeast Asia, Thailand covers a total area of approximately 513,000 square kilometers (198,000 square miles) and is the 50th largest country in the world and the 12th largest in Asia!

BANGKOK

Bangkok, capital of Thailand and one of Asia's most dynamic cities, offers surprises at every turn. Gleaming skyscrapers, glittering temples, colourful street markets, sophisticated shopping malls, bustling nightlife, all jumbled together in a completely wild and exotic atmosphere. It is cheap while

at the same time providing excellent standards.

That goes for food as well as for accommodation.

AIRPORT

Suvernabhumi International Airport in Bangkok is the main air gateway into Thailand. It serves more than 50 international airlines, representing every major carrier in the world. Apart from Suvernabhumit Airport, regional airports, such as Chiang Mai International Airport, Phuket International Airport and privately owned Samui International Airport, serve a small number of direct international arrivals and departures each day.



Voltage, Sockets and Plugs

Thailand's voltage is 220-240AC, 50 Hertz. The plugs in Thailand are not standardized — there are at least three different types, some two pin and some three, so be sure to either bring a universal adapter or buy one once you arrive in Thailand.

tart your Bangkok temple tour at the Grand Palace and Wat Phra Kaew, or Temple of the Emerald Buddha. This Buddhist temple was built inside the grounds of the Grand Palace and is the most visited of all the Bangkok temples. Carved into a block of jade, the Emerald Buddha — who wears one of three royal robes depending on the season — is the well-known icon of this temple and to the Thai people, even though it's a relatively small icon standing at only 66cm. THAILAND AIRPORTS

These days we have many international airlines from many countries all over the world operating from Don Mueang and Suvarnabhumi, making these some of the most important airports in South East Asia. There are also international airports in tourist popular provinces of Thailand such as

Chiang Mai, Chiang Rai, Phuket, Hat Yai, Udon Thani, and Krabi.

Arrivals Your arrival at the main terminal building may be through a terminal gate or bus gate, depending on your airline and flight route. For bus gates, you will be brought to within a few hundred meters of Immigration (located on the second floor)
whereas via the terminal gates,
youmay have to walk for quite a
bit before getting to Immigration.
There are plenty of restaurants,
phone shops with SIM cards, and
ATMs outside customs in the
arrival's hall at Bangkok Airport.

assengers Arrival/Arriving Passengers

passengers Arrival must fill in their personal information on the Passenger Arrival Document no. 6 which is issued by the Immigration Bureau as evidence for contacting passengers while they are staying in Thailand. The staff of the airline you travel with will give the aforementioned document to passengers so that they can fill it in before the plane lands (traveling to Thailand).



Visas and Travel Document

Passengers who do not have arrival visas (please see the list of countries below) can apply for visas at the arrival counter by bringing 2 one-inch photos and paying the fee of 300 Baht. Passengers who do not have photos can use photo express service in the airport at 120 Baht (4 photos).

Departure

All departures at Bangkok Airport are handled at the airline check-in counters located on the fourth floor. Domestic check-ins are from Rows B to C. Row A is dedicated to Thai Airways' Royal First Class and Royal Silk passengers.

For international departures, proceed to Rows D to W. Always be prepared to arrive at least two hours before international departures or one hour before domestic departures. http://www.bangkok.com/information/airport.htm?cid=ch:OTH:001

WEATHER

Thailand is located between vast areas of land and water, so it is impacted by both the summerand the winter monsoons. As a result, Thailand weather consists of six months of rainfalls during the wet season, three months of dry and cooling breezes during the cool season, and three months of heat during the hot season. The average temperature of Thailand ranges from 18 to 38°C.

The hot season is from the middle of February to the middle of May, with April being the hottest month. Interesting places to visit during this period are beaches and islands in the South and the East of Thailand.

Time Difference

Thailand follows UTC+07:00, which is 7 hours ahead of UTC. The local mean time in Bangkok was originally UTC+06:42:04.
[1] Thailand used this local mean time until 1920, when it changed to Indochina Time, GMT+07:00, ICT is used all year round as Thailand does not observe daylight saving time.

Currency

The currency in Thailand is called the Thai baht (pronounced baht) and is usually represented by an uppercase 'B" with slash through it. When you are shopping in stores, you will see this on the price tags. While you can use US. dollars in some

countries, they're not widely accepted in Thailand. You will need to exchange for the baht. https://www.tourismthailand.org/About-Thailand/Bank-Currency-Converter





National Archery Association of Thailand has Organized Many Successful PARA Archery Events in the past such as Asian PARA Archery and PARA – Archery World Championships.














CLASSIFICATION

Medical intake forms can only be submitted by the Member Association and must be sent by email to World Archery (classification@archery.org) at least 30 days prior to the date of the classification (18 October 2019).

Failure to do so will result in no classification for the archer, and will not be allowed to shoot in the competition. Archers scheduled for classification must arrive in Bangkok one day before. Archers who are late for classification will not be classified.
