PRELIMINARY & FINAL REGISTRATION

All entries, accommodation reservations, transport needs, flight arrival/departure information and visa invitation letter requests are to be completed using the World Archery Online Registration System WAREOS <u>https://extranet.worldarchery.sport</u>. This system handles the entire registration process for this event. No entry forms, hotel reservations or transportation forms will be accepted; all information must be entered into WAREOS.

Member associations can login to WAREOS at <u>http://extranet.worldarchery.sport</u> with the username and password assigned by World Archery. After entering WAREOS, selecting the event from the list will allow a member association to register their athletes. Select/press the "Entries" button to see the list of categories in the event. Select/press the "category" to enter the athlete and official numbers/details participating for that event. A WAREOS User Manual can be downloaded in PDF format (English) upon login.

Contact <u>wareos@archery.sport</u> with any questions regarding <u>technical problems on WAREOS</u>. For any question regarding the organisation of the event (transport, accommodation, meals, invoices, visa etc.) please contact <u>directly the LOC</u>.

Athletes from a minimum of 4 different Member Associations shall be registered and participate in the event.

A maximum number of 4 athletes per country can be registered into each category and division of the event. Preliminary entries should be completed using WAREOS.

Please respect the stated deadlines.

Member Associations can only use WAREOS to make any changes or amendments to entries and will be able to do so at any time. An email will automatically notify the Organising Committee and Member Association of any changes made in WAREOS.

Any changes that are made after the deadlines specified or if entries differ by more than 4 athletes from the preliminary entries, the following penalty fees will automatically be applied.



Entry Fee :

ENTRY FEES IN NON-OFFICIAL HOTELS

Individual	: 500 USD per athlete
Official	: 250 USD per person

Entry fees for individual/Official/Teams include, daily local transport to and from the practice field to/from official hotels during the qualification, elimination and finals venues (timetable to be confirmed on site).

Entry fee for guest includes daily local transport to and from the practice field to/from official hotels during the qualification, elimination and finals venues. They have <u>no field of play access</u>.

Any changes made after the deadlines specified or if entries differ by more than 4 athletes from the preliminary entries, the following penalty fees to will automatically be applied:

Member Associations that have penalty fees outstanding from 2020 will need to have paid these penalty fees before being eligible to enter and compete.

Entries received after the deadlines, are subject to penalties as clearly stated in the rule book and the invitation documents of World Cups and World Championships. A Member Association that has made final entries in WAREOS and does not participate will be invoiced for the number of entries entered in the system, unless they have informed World Archery and the Organising Committee in writing at least one week prior to the event that they are unable to attend.





VISA

COVID TEST FEES

100 USD per athlete/official

This fee includes 03 (three) COVID tests from arrival day of the delegations until the last test necessary before departure on 1st, 3rd day and on 5th day.

All participants must come with RTPCR negative tests taken 48 hours before arrival in New Delhi.

PAYMENT CONDITIONS:

Complete all necessary sections in WAREOS and make full payment by the specified deadlines. Bank transfers or cash only, no credit cards will be accepted. All bank charges will be paid by the participants.

In addition, the LOC will be responsible to provide any event information at this hotel and provide transportation to the venues. Private vehicles cannot be used.

To confirm hotels reservations, a minimum 50% deposit of the total amount is required to be bank transferred to the OC before **20 April 2022**. Reservations after this date will be considered only according to availability. The final outstanding balance shall be made via bank transfer before arrival or by cash before official practice. Accommodation cannot be guaranteed after this deadline. A balanced invoice will be provided via WAREOS.

The entry fees and COVID test fees should be paid in full before official practice to the LOC.

PERSONAL HYGIENE AND HEALTH ADVICES (COVID-19)

INFORMATION

Everybody should follow the Government/public health authorities measures (national and sport-specific regulations) and be aware of the travel restrictions

For your information, Medical infrastructure/Hospital with proper care will be reachable within 15 minutes from the venue, where COVID-19 test can be done

PERSONAL HYGIENE AND HEALTH ADVICES

- Anyone due to participate in the event who is feeling ill should not attend
- Participants (athlete, volunteer, official etc.) should proactively and regularly check their health status (including taking their temperature and monitoring for any symptoms)
- Stay home and self-isolate even with minor symptoms for 10 days or more depending on national protocols, when showing any symptoms (fever, tiredness, dry cough, headache, nasal congestion, runny nose, sore throat, difficulty breathing).
- Contact a healthcare provider immediately if any respiratory illness is noted
- Masks to be worn at all times everywhere (transport, common area in the hotel, venue, training etc.) except on shooting line
- Regularly and thoroughly clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand rub or wash them with soap and water
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth
- Cover your mouth and nose with your bent elbow or tissue when you cough or sneeze. Then dispose of the used tissue immediately and wash your hands
- Avoid touching high-contact surfaces such as door handles, walls or windows, etc.
- Avoid going to crowded places
- Avoid steam rooms or saunas
- No spitting, as the main mode of transmission of the virus is in respiratory secretions
- No handshakes, high fives and any other personal contact
- Athletes should not share clothing, bar soap, sports equipment, water bottles or other personal items

CLASSIFICATION

For countries which have athletes needing to be classified for the first time or who have "Review" status which requires a further classification, please complete the classification application form and medical intake form for each person and send it to classification@archery.sport, no later than 30th April 2022.

Failure to do so will result in no classification for the archer, and will not be allowed to shoot in the competition. Archers scheduled for classification must arrive in Delhi one day before. Archers who are late for classification will not be classified.

New classification for VI archers will apply. A classification session will be organized.

VI archers with review status or with only national classification shall be classified on place.








Delhi Airport Terminal 3 is the newest terminal. It was opened in 2010 and is one of the biggest Terminals in the world, being able to handle 40 million passengers per year.

All International flights are operated from T3 and some domestic flights too.

IGI TERMINAL 3

Delhi Airport Terminal 3 consist of five levels as follows: Each level is split into the international and domestic areas.

Ground level : Arrivals area. Domestic Arrivals are accessed from domestic arrivals pier, while international arrivals are accessed from the international pier. Passengers will find access to transportation options and several services too. First level : Departures area. Access to international and domestic gates are separated.

- Domestic Departures concourse: Section C (gates 27-36), Section D (37-41 and 42-62).

- International Departures concourse: Section A (gates 1-3 and 4-14), Section B (gates 15-26).

Second level : It houses some airport lounges and the food court. Third level : Airport lounges. Fourth level : Airport lounges area. Fifth level :The Transit Hotel (international and domestic wings).

Delhi – The Heart of India



Delhi, India's national capital is the city fusion of the myriad cultures of India. That is why, it is often referred to as the heart of India. Delhi has been the political hub of India.

The city has an amazingly rich history and culture. Noticeably, Delhi has always enjoyed the status of being a capital city. Many a times the city was built, destroyed and then rebuilt here. Interestingly, a number of Delhi's rulers played a dual role, first as destroyers and then as creators. All the rulers, from the early Muslim Sultans to the British, have left their indelible marks on this city in the form of its elegant monuments.

Top Tourist Attractions



Red Fort built by Shahjahan, the builder of Taj

Mahal in Agra, named for its massive enclosing walls of red sandstone. The Red Fort is an iconic symbol of India. On the Independence Day, the Prime Minister of India hoists the national flag here.

India Gate is a memorial raised in honour of the Indian soldiers who died during the Afghan wars and World War I. The names of the soldiers who died in these wars are inscribed on the walls. The cenotaph (or shrine) in the middle is constructed with black marble and depicts a rifle placed on its barrel, crested by a soldier's helmet.







due to its distinctive lotus shaped design in Marble. It was built in 1987 by the followers of Bahai faith. The temple signifies the purity and equality of all religions.



Qutub Minar is an excellent example of Afghan Architecture. The Minar is 72.5mts high victory tower, the construction of which began in the final year of twelfth century by Qutubuddin Aibak and was later completed by his successor. It has been given World Heritage Site status.

Swaminarayan Akshardham in New Delhi epitomizes 10,000 years of Indian culture in all its breathtaking grandeur, beauty, wisdom and bliss. It brilliantly showcases the essence of India's ancient architecture, traditions and timeless spiritual messages.





Around Delhi

The Taj Mahal is a white marble mausoleum located in Agra, Uttar Pradesh and just 210 Km away from Delhi. It was built by Mughal emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his third wife, Mumtaz Mahal. In 1983, the Taj Mahal became a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The construction began around 1632 and was completed around 1653, employing thousands of artisans and craftsmen.



Ranthambore National Park is one of the biggest and most renowned national park in Northern India. The park is located in the southeastern Rajasthan, which is about 364 km from Delhi. It is major wildlife tourist attraction spot that has pulled the attention of many wildlife photographers and lovers in this destination.
