JUDGES

Mr Harold R. Kremer (USA)

Recently FITA was informed that the retired FITA Judge Mr Harold R. Kremer passed away on 6 February 2007. The cause of his death was congestive heart failure due to complications related to Myasthenia Gravis.

Harold Kremer was born on 29 May 1921. Archery was a passion of his that started in the late sixties and lasted until he died. He continued to shoot until 2005 when his failing strength would no longer allow him to do so. Harold was a US, International and Olympic Judge. He was the USA Archery Team manager for the 1980 Olympics.

Mr René Lin (MON)

It is with great sadness that the Archery Association of Monaco announced the passing of Mr René Lin, one of its most important members, on 20 August 2007. Mr Lin was a well appreciated FITA International Judge and was a great contributor to Archery in Monaco.

FITA expresses our heartfelt condolences to both Mr Kremer's and Mr Lin's families and friends.
