#### FAA adopts Development Plan and Pathway Programme

The Federation of African Archery (FAA) held its Council meeting in Casablanca (MAR) on 7-8 May 2011 where it unveiled its future plans for developing the sport on the African continent. According to FAA President Dr Aladdin GABR, "the new mission and vision will serve the future needs of Africa, allowing the sport of archery to take its rightful place."

In unveiling the mission to create support and to enhance a sustainable athlete, judge and coaches programme, along with sustainable events on the continent partnering with all interested parties; the future aims and goals were set. These goals are designed to empower the continental development coordinator for Africa to work with Member Associations to develop archery in Africa and to increase the number of active national federations, athletes, coaches and officials within the FAA through effective pathways from grassroots to Olympic level.

Releasing the development programme which caters for all aspects of the sport, the Council adopted the practical programme and expects to see measureable results and outcomes within the next 12-18 months. "This is the first time that the FAA has set a direction for Member Associations in a tangible and practical way, allowing them to have proper guidelines and a road-map to ensure national development."

In addition, a number of recommendations to overcome obstacles were presented by the Continental Development Officer and Council Member, Dr Selwyn MOSKOVITZ.

In an extremely positive first day session, the Council finalised the various technical committees and provided both the mandate and timelines for certain outcomes which were aimed at developing archery in Africa.

The development plan which covers the period 2011-2013 was met with enthusiasm and will result in a schedule of training seminars to escalate technical skills such as coaching and judges to a continental level allowing the FITA flag to be flown at more Member Associations' national championships.

# **Member Associations**

#### Germany

The 57th General Assembly of the German Shooting and Archery Federation (DSB) on 30 April 2011 was the start of the 150 years celebrations of the Deutsche Schutzenbund. DSB has the honour to be the oldest German national sports federation as well as have the oldest club of German sports history. The General Assembly was attended by all the delegates of the federation as well as representatives of the National Olympic Committee (DOSB) and the Federal and Regional governments. FITA was represented by the Secretary General Tom DIELEN.

The DSB President, Mr Joseph AMBACHER, addressed the festive gathering which included a special remembrance to the people who had passed away in

the last two years. This included Franz BAUM, the former national coach who played a key role in the history of German Archery.

The FITA Secretary General illustrated in his speech the long history of DSB as a FITA member and highlighted the role of Konrad AICHENMULLER, who is known as the father of German Archery and who played an important role in the lead up to the return of archery at the 1972 Olympic Games. His wife attended the General Assembly and the FITA Secretary General was able to thank her personally for her husband's contribution.

Tom DIELEN also mentioned the success of the athletes and especially the women's team at the Atlanta and Sydney Games. He thanked DSB for the important role their representatives play in FITA and ask for continuous support of DSB in the future.

#### **Bhutan Archery Centre**

The Bhutanese archery has a very new and quite impressive archery centre, situated in Thimpu on the edge of the river. They are currently completing it by securing the river banks to avoid flooding.

Bhutan had recently held a shoot out to select their ten best archers and their two Olympic Solidarity scholarship holders were amongst them. They are now training these 10 archers who participated in the Asian Grand Prix in Bangladesh. They currently have a Korean coach who prepared their delegation for the Grand Prix (4 archers and 3 officials).

















The two scholarship holders Mr Yeshey DHENDUP and Miss Dorji DOLMA are enthusiastic at the chance to participate in the World Championships in Turin in July and hopefully in the London 2012 Olympic Games.

# **Para-Archery**

### **Rounds for Compound**

At the World Archery Para Championships to be held in Turin, Italy in July 2011, the compound archers will shoot the same as the recurve archers, that is the FITA Round, which is 144 arrows shot at 90, 70, 50, 30m for men and 144 arrows at 70m, 60m, 50m, 30m for women and W1 archers.

The match play will be at 70m on the full 122cm face for everyone.

It seems that some people were not aware of this decision taken before the start of the qualification period for the Paralympic Games. The reason for this decision to retain the 70m Round for compound para-archers is because the programme for the Paralympic Games in London 2012 was set before FITA changed the shooting distance for compound shooting.

The rounds to be shot in London next year will be at 70m for both compound and recurve.

To make sure compound para-archers have the most time to train and win places for London, FITA decided to keep the 70m distances until after the 2012 Paralympic Games. So apart from the World Championships 2011, all other major Para-Archery competitions will be shot at the 70m distance on the full 122cm face for compound archers.

This only applies to Para-Archery tournaments.

If compound para-archers shoot in a tournament open to everyone, they will shoot the Compound 50m Round like everyone else.

#### **Classification of Archers**

An important part of the Para-Archery competition is the classification of the archers.

Because different forms of disability can influence people differently the archer needs to undergo a set of specific tests, the outcome of which will then decide in which class the archer will compete.

The people who administer these tests are called "Classifiers" and they usually have specific professional qualifications in their general lives. They may be doctors, physiotherapists, etc., who have a detailed understanding of how the human body works.

The tests will check the range of movement and the strength of the muscles in the arms, legs and spine.

After this classification process the archer will be given a card which indicates if the archer is W1 - most severely disabled, W2 - still in a wheelchair, or ST which means the athlete is able to stand but may also use a stool to shoot from.

To ensure there is continuity of classification throughout the world FITA has established an ad hoc committee chaired by the FITA Chief Classifier Pauline BETTERIDGE. This committee is working on a manual for archery Classifiers. There will be seminars at which classifiers may be trained, or upskilled to a higher level.

The FITA Judges system of training, examination and regular case studies to ensure Judges are up to date with their knowledge will be used as the example for the on-going training and education of Classifiers.

#### **World Ranking Event in Bangkok**

The 1st Asian Para-Archery Championships was held in Bangkok, Thailand from 10-18 May 2011. Altogether 63 archers from 10 nations (nine from Asia and one from Europe) participated in this event. The participating nations were Hong Kong-China, India, Italy, Iraq, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Mongolia, Chinese Taipei and Thailand. The Opening Ceremony was held at the Rajamangala National Stadium on 12 May 2011. FITA Vice President Mr Sanguan KOSAVINTA delivered the welcome message on behalf of FITA President Prof Dr Ugur ERDENER.

# **Past Events**

#### World Cup Stage 1 Porec

The first stage of the World Cup season was held in Porec, Croatia on 2-7 May 2011. The morning session on Saturday 7 May in downtown Porec was devoted to the Finals in the compound division at the first World Cup stage of the year. Compound matches were all shot at 50 metres. USA's dominance in the compound division was shown once again with four wins out of five events.













In individual Rodger WILLET Jr. and Erika ANSCHUTZ clinched gold shooting close to perfection. USA also won the competition in men's team and mixed team. Only the women's team event was taken by another country, France.

Saturday afternoon brought the World Cup Stage 1 to an end. It featured all finals in the recurve division, with matches being shot at 70m. Korea and USA took all five gold medals in recurve. The reigning World Cup Final winner Brady ELLISON led the American team, winning the men's individual and team events and taking silver in the mixed team competition. The Korean HAN Gyeonghee clinched the women's individual and team gold medals, while her fellow countrymen JUNG Dasomi and OH Jin Hyek won the mixed event.

The Swiss watch-maker LONGINES launched the LONGINES Precision Prize for archery in 2010. Each year, the two most precise archers win the trophy, a watch and a 5,000 Swiss Francs prize and this time the compound archers are in the race. The compound athletes shoot for it in odd-years, while the recurve athletes compete for the Prize in even years. Last year, recurve archers Brady ELLISON (USA) and Justyna MOSPINEK (POL) won the prize.

In 2011, the compound men and women athletes who shoot the most 10s during the individual qualifications and the matches as of the 1/16 eliminations of the World Cup will win the prize. The race for the LONGINES Precision Prize should go on until the very last match at the World Cup Final in Istanbul!

#### World Cup Stage 4 Shanghai

Due to a mistake of FITA, the FORS system was not opened on time for the preliminary entries in Shanghai. For this reason we will extent the preliminary entry deadline for two weeks till **21 June 2011**. However, we ask our Member Associations to do the preliminary entries as soon as possible and not wait until the last moment. We hope that this will allow all Member Associations to do their preliminary entries on time.

#### World Archery Youth Championships 2011 Legnica

Based on the Preliminary entries world titles will be held in all categories and events. Currently 531 athletes are registered from 46 countries.













Tickets for the World Archery Youth Championships 2011 went on sale on 1 May 2011. Fans can buy their tickets online for the finals to be held on 27 and 28 August in Legnica, Poland. #### World Archery Championships 2011 Turin

#### Volunteers

The recruitment of volunteers for the World Archery and Para-Archery Championships to be held in Turin, Italy in July 2011 came to an end. The event is forecast as the biggest archery event ever. More than 350 applications were received from all over Italy and Europe. More than 450 people will work together to organise the best possible World Archery Championships. A special logo was designed and is dedicated to all the volunteers.



The Organising Committee (OC) started to receive applications in January 2011, with the impressive target to reach a complete crew of 250 peoples. Such a high number was requested to face the unusual length of the event that will start on 28 June 2011 with open practice and will finish on 18 July with teams departure after the para-archery competition.

The latest archery events held in Turin, such as the European Indoor and Italian Target Championships, showed that the OC could count on a large number of archers who love the idea to cooperate for the success of an event. But nobody had expected such a great enthusiasm from all over Italy and Europe. In less than two months more than 350 people applied to become volunteers, forcing the OC to make a selection among them, according to availability, skills, and previous experience.

Furthermore, a post-Olympic organisation called VOLA, "anti-doping volunteers Stefania Belmondo", will cooperate with the OC offering their experience acquired since the Turin 2006 Winter Olympic Games. This organisation, founded after the Games, gathered all the people who fell in love with working for sport and helped in a lot of others events, such as Fencing, Cycling, Skating, and Volleyball World Championships or Air Games held in Turin in the last five years.

In Turin 2011, these experienced people will help archery delegations in transportation and accommodation. They will be present in the official buses, in the airports and hotels, while volunteering archers will work directly on the field. In total 450 people will be working together to organise the best possible World Archery Championships.

#### Archery Demo at Football Match

The World Archery and Para Championships 2011 are approaching. As part of the programme to launch the event to be held in Turin, Italy from 3-17 July 2011, the Italian archers Marco GALIAZZO, Natalia VALEEVA, Oscar DE PELLEGRIN and Elisabetta MIJNO competed on Monday night 9 May 2011 during the break at the Serie A football match between Juventus and Chievo the last home game of the season and the last game ever played at the Stadio Olimpico in Turin.

The Olympic champion Marco GALIAZZO and the world champion Natalia VALEEVA along with the Paralympic athletes Oscar DE PELLEGRIN and Elisabetta MIJNO had a double challenge in an exceptional showcase demo: the football league Serie A.



When the two football teams were back in the locker room after the first 45 minutes of the game, the spotlight was turned to the archers of the archery national team, who shot a single 3-arrow end match at a 70metre distance.

Marco GALIAZZO, individual gold medal at the Athens 2004 Olympic Games and team silver at the Beijing 2008 Games challenged the several time world champion Natalia VALEEVA, the top Italian female archer. The two athletes were close, but after three arrows GALIAZZO won 29-28.

The other challenge was a match between the European champions in para mixed team: Oscar DE PELLEGRIN, Paralympic gold medallist and world record holder, flanked on the shooting line Elisabetta MIJNO, member of Italian para-archery team. DE PELLEGRIN shot a perfect score and won the demo by 30-28.

#### **Press Conference**

The first numbers of the World Archery and Para Championships which will be held in the Hunting Palace of Stupinigi and Piazza Castello in Turin on 3-17 July 2011 were presented on Wednesday morning 25 May at Palazzo Cisterna, headquarters of the province of Turin. The event has a record preliminary registration with 653 archers, 271 technicians and 87 participating nations.

In the presence of the owner Antonio SAITTA and his deputy commissioner of sports Gianfranco PORQUEDDU, the president of the Organising Committee (OC) Tiziana NASI, the president of the European Archery 2004 Olympic champion Marco GALIAZZO and M'arco the mascot



Association (EMAU) and Italian Archery Federation (FITARCO) Mario SCARZELLA and the competition manager Ardingo SCARZELLA have outlined the first issues in the event with a record pre-registration of 653 archers, 271 technicians and 87 participating nations.

The World Championships 2011 in Turin are part of the official calendar of events for the celebrations of the 150th anniversary of Italy: "Targeting the celebrations of the 150th on large international sporting events like the World Archery Championships has been a very definite choice," says SAITTA. "Sport in general, in fact, not just football, has always been one of the factors that can make a strong Italian character and able to create in the minds a strong sense of belonging."

The meeting also addressed the commissioner for sport and culture of the city of Nichelino Carmen BONINO, who together with the OC director general Odilia COCCATO explained the project to promote archery in all primary and secondary schools of Nichelino which is taking place in collaboration with FITARCO Regional Committee through cycles of lessons taught by federal archery instructors.

During the presentation, the 2004 Olympic champion Marco GALIAZZO was also the spokesperson for the presentation of the mascot: M'arco, a deer with the tricolour target on his stomach that recalls the statue on top of the Hunting Palace of Stupinigi.

#### **African Championships 2012**

In a move towards escalating the standing of the sport of archery on the African continent, the Federation of African Archery (FAA) enlisted the services of Mrs Barbara MANNING of South Africa, accredited to manage major events, to prepare a standard bidding document to host major events.

This resulted in the heightening of standards for the Continental Games, requiring the bidding country to partner with the host city and to meet requirements expected of World Archery standards. The bidding was narrowed

down to Namibia and Morocco, and after a presentation by the same company who was responsible for organising a number of major events in the northern African country, the bid was awarded to Morocco.

Excitement was at a high due to the speculation and the process was covered by the national TV stations and press, with the conference room bursting into applause by the spectators when the outcome of the final bid was made known after verification by three FAA Council Members.

The 9th FAA Championships and Olympic Qualifier will be held at the Moulay Rachid Sports Complex in the Capital city Rabat on 12-16 March 2012 and World Ranking will be applied. The organisers expect the championships to be the showcase of archery, the city and the local culture, together with the backing of the national sports ministry and host city.

#### Youth Olympic Games 2014 Nanjing

With 1185 days to go, Nanjing has proudly unveiled their rockin' emblem for the Summer Youth Olympic Games in 2014. Launched with a grand ceremony, broadcast live on national television to audiences across China, the emblem is bursting with colour and energy in celebration of the youth of today.

Speaking at the launch event, IOC President Jacques ROGGE said: "This colourful and contemporary logo is the perfect symbol for Nanjing and China as a whole. He continued: "It also represents the energy of the city and the nation, and it is this vibrancy that will inspire young people around the world to join in the celebrations in 2014."
