Olympic Games

Archery reaches a higher sports grouping

On 29 May 2013 the IOC President announced the new groups of the Olympic Sports that gives, as the ASOIF President stated, a recognition to the contribution of the sport to the success of the Olympic Games.

These groupings are based on a series of objective factors that include TV ratings, popularity of a sport on the internet, social media, press articles and interest shown by the public universally. Archery, to go with its core sports status, has now been promoted to Group C (together with badminton, boxing, judo, rowing, shooting, table tennis and weightlifting).

World Archery President, Prof. Dr Ugur ERDENER stated: "Archery in 2006, started a strategic plan with a vision to make Archery an important Olympic sport at an international level in 2012. The IOC, today with the new grouping, confirmed that this vision has been completed. We thank all the athletes, officials, staff, broadcasters, spectators and members of the Archery Family for this great accomplishment. Archery is a loyal member of the Olympic Family and continues to work so that in Rio we will be even more successful. We thank also the IOC for the incredible work done as part of this study."

World Archery is now working on the next strategic plan which is to assist the Member Associations in achieving the same level of recognition nationally on a worldwide level.

Congress: deadlines reminder

Here are the upcoming deadlines regarding next Congress, which will be held in Belek Antalya on 27 and 28 September 2013:

- Candidatures for elections have to be send to the Secretary General before **29 June 2013**, in order to be published with documents on 12 July 2013. Late candidatures are possible until **6 September 2013**, but will not be published before Congress.
- Proxies must be sent to WA office by 28 August 2013.

World Archery Plaquettes

Should anyone wish to propose one of its officials or athletes for a World Archery Plaquette, we remind of the procedures listed in the rule book.

If you wish them to be allocated in the next Congress please send any proposal, seconded by another Member Association or Executive Board member before 30 June 2013.

World Archery awards Plaquettes in the following circumstances:

For all Plaquettes the following criteria shall apply:

- Only current or former members of Member Associations can receive a Plaquette;
- A Plaquette cannot be awarded to a person that has violated and has been sanctioned for a breach of the Code of Ethics and Conduct;
- Plaquettes are not to be automatically awarded simply because someone has fulfilled a
 function that is eligible for a Plaquette. An application for a plaquette shall be filed and
 approved by the Board of Trustees who shall then recommend the application to the
 Executive Board or Congress as appropriate;
- A recipient of a Plaquette can be awarded another Plaquette both of a higher and lower value;
- The application shall be seconded by another Member Association or Executive Board Member;
- Applications should include a CV of the candidate or a full description of why you feel that this person should be awarded a plaquette.

Clean Sport

Important message for all Member Associations

We would like to remind all Member Associations that notice of sanctions taken at the national level and their reasoned decisions must be sent to the World Archery Office as soon as the decisions are taken.

Communication of sanctions

The archer Mr Sebastian BATOR (POL) has been sanctioned by the Polish Archery Association, as follows:

- Disqualification of individual and team results obtained on 10.02.2013, including forfeiture of any medals, points and prizes.
- 1 year suspension starting on 10.02.2013.
- Anti-doping rule violated according to the World Anti-Doping Code, Art.2.1: Presence of a prohibited substance, its metabolites or its markers in an athlete's sample.

The archer Mr Licko MAREK (SVK) has been sanctioned by the Slovak Archery Association, as follows:

- Disqualification of individual and team results obtained on 24.10.2012, including forfeiture of any medals, points and prizes.
- 1 year suspension starting on 01.03.2013.
- Anti-doping rule violated according to the World Anti-Doping Code, Art.2.1: Presence of a prohibited substance, its metabolites or its markers in an athlete's sample.

Past Events

Shanghai World Cup Stage 1

The recurve mixed team and individual finals brought to a close the Shanghai World Cup that took place from 13-19 May 2013. The USA won the mixed team gold medal, and Korea confirmed supremacy on the individual side, taking two gold medals. Korea won the men's team gold, returning to the top after losing the Olympic crown last year. On the women's side, the young team of Chinese Taipei won their first World Cup title, showing they are ready to be major players for years to come.

In the compound mixed team and individual finals the man of the day was Braden GELLENTHIEN (USA), who won individual, team and mixed team gold medals. The women's competition emphasised the new dominance of SEOK Ji Hyun (KOR) who won individual and team golds, plus the mixed team silver. In the compound team finals the United States easily won the men's title, as Korea won their first ever compound women's gold medal at a World Cup. Information and results...

First School Olympics in UAE

The "First School Olympics" was organised from 28-30 April 2013 in Abu Dhabi, United Arab of Emirates. The competition included six sports (Archery, Athletics, Fencing, Gymnastics, Shooting and Swimming). 90 athletes (45 boys and 45 girls) aged 13-14 years old represented nine school districts from all over the United Arab of Emirates participated in the archery tournament. The main objective of this project was to identify the best archers through these centres who will then take part in the National School Olympics event. The project was to select 10 best archers and train them until a specific date. Then the best 4 archers were selected to attend the major event that took place in Armed Forces Officers Club in Abu Dhabi. More information...

World Masters Games

The deadline for entries has been extended to 30 June 2013. We remind all of our Member Associations and athletes that the athletes enter as individual athletes and not as national teams. There are different age groups starting at 30+ and there is a special para-archery event. Currently 160 athletes have registered from more than 25 countries. Every participant will receive a participation package which includes a backpack, a T-shirt, a cap and many other useful things for their stay in Torino.

Important clarification in terms of the medical certificate and membership requirements

A meeting took place between World Archery and the LOC in the IMGA General Assembly and the conclusion is the following: no medical certificate is required for all athletes that can show a membership card of any World Archery Member Associations that is valid for the period of the Games. In case no membership certificate or card can be shown, a medical certificate will need to be obtained. For the ones that have a membership card, the medical certificate is considered to be an implicit requirement of becoming member of the association concerned. However, it is of course obvious that all participants should check that they have a medical insurance in place that covers any medical issue during their stay in Torino.

We also remind our members that the next European Games will be in Nice, France, and that there is discussion to have archery at the Pan American Master Games in Vancouver.

World Ranking Event in Australia

Coaching

Level 2 Coaching Course in Bangkok

Coaches were given an opportunity to be trained as level 2 archery coaches on 20-26 May 2013. The course took place at the Bangkok Archery Centre with a total of 14 participants from Algeria, Bangladesh, Czech Republic, Hong Kong, India, Iran, Malaysia, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Sudan, and Thailand.

At level 2, the coach candidates learn how to assist the recent archer to get specialised with the recurve and compound bows in target archery and eventually for para-archery.



On the programme there are also several modules preparing the participants to the establishment of a training plan. This preparation included several sport generic modules, such as psychology, biomechanics, fight against doping, etc. Some specialists were invited to lecture for some of these generic sport modules, while most of the training was delivered by the resident Coach KIM Sun Bin (KOR) assisted by a National Coach Mr KOMPATH. The WA Development Director Pascal COLMAIRE completed the lecturers' team.

Since none of the World Archery Member Associations and members of the World Archery Council has risen any objection to the World Archery Office, the Rwanda Archery Federation has become a temporary World Archery member since 1 June 2013. The final membership of this association will be submitted to a vote at the next World Archery Congress on 27-28 September 2013.

Call for objection

Bahamas has submitted a membership application file conformed to the WA Rule 1.4.2. According this rule, the current World Archery Member Associations and the members of the Council have 60 days in which to put in writing to the World Archery Office any objection to this request of membership.

Without any serious objection within these 60 days (1 June 2013 to 1 August 2013), a temporary membership will be granted to the **Bahamas Archery Federation** until the 2013 Congress. The final membership of this national archery association will be submitted to a vote during this Congress.
