### Rio 2016

Sport sessions and prices for Rio 2016 Olympic and Paralympic Games will be revealed in November before Brazilian resident and worldwide sales open during early 2015. Tickets to watch the archery events will be priced at as little as 20 USD for the elimination rounds. The cheapest tickets for the finals will cost just double that, as Rio 2016 bids to set prices that ensure the Games are open to everyone.

## Archery World Cup

### Lausanne 2014

The Archery World Cup Final 2014 was held in Lausanne on 6/7 September. Both compound winners at Lausanne 2014 can still shoot as juniors. Bridger DEATON, in his first international with the USA men's team, beat experienced teammate Reo WILDE on his way to a final against world number one PJ DELOCHE – in which the Frenchman could not seem to find his groove.



DEATON's women's teammate Erika JONES lost the World Cup Final gold medal match to a Colombian compound archer for the second year in a row. This time it was Sara LOPEZ – the 15-arrow-match world record holder – rather than Alejandra USQUIANO.

The first recurve archer to win back-to-back World Cup Finals became the first athlete – in any division – to win three total. Team USA's Brady ELLISON, who has not been off the Archery World Cup Final podium since his first win in 2010, beat the youngest-ever finalist in a shoot-off to take recurve men's gold.



Marcus D'ALMEDIA took silver at the age of 16. The Brazilian has a bright future ahead of him, and recently won silver at the Youth Olympic Games in Nanjing.



Silver medallist at the last full Olympic Games in London, though, was Aida ROMAN. Mexico's best-known athlete in the sport was back on the podium in Lausanne – this time with gold. She beat CHENG Ming from China in the final.

## World Championships

### 3D World Championships 2015 – 2017

At the occasion of the Executive Committee in September, the candidatures for future 3D World Championships were discussed. It was clear that both candidatures – from France and Italy – could deliver excellent events. In the end, Terni (ITA) was designated as host for the 2015 World Archery 3D Championships.

For 2017 World Archery has so far received interest from Romania who also wishes to do the 2016 World Archery Field Championships.



### Copenhagen 2015

Next year's archery highlight will be the World Archery Championships in Copenhagen, Denmark from 26 July to 2 August 2015. The world's best archers will shoot for gold and glory in front of the Danish Parliament at Christiansborg Slotsplads, with the ruling World Champion and Danish Sport's Name of the Year 2013, Maja JAGER, in front.

As an extra spice, it will also be the first chance for the archers to qualify for the Rio 2016 Olympics in Brazil. The 3D graphics of the finals venue on Christiansborg Slotsplads have been released at [www.archerycopenhagen.com](http://www.archerycopenhagen.com).



## Continental Games

### Incheon 2014

Korea had its sights on four to six golds at the first ever Asian Games to include a compound competition. The nation ended up with five: all four available in the women's events, plus Olympic Champion OH Jin Hyek's rallying victory in the recurve men's individual final.

India's compound men beat Korea in the compound men's team final, while Esmail EBADI of Iran won the individual event. China decisively beat Malaysia in the recurve men's team gold medal match.

## Other Events

### Invictus Games

The first edition of a new multisport event for sick, injured or wounded veterans of armed forces. Including athletes from 13 nations, the archery competition at the Invictus Games included recurve, compound and novice mixed-gender categories. Novice archers had to have no more than three months experience in archery.



Shooting in a striking, black and yellow arena with a 1,000-strong crowd – including the Games' patron, Prince Harry of the British royal family – the finals were as enthralling as any major international, thanks to the athletes' obvious passion.

Top qualifier in the novice competition, Italy's Fabio TOMASULO scored 545/600 for 60 arrows on an 80-centimetre target face at 18 metres using nothing more than a World Archery standard training bow. Amazing!

### Mexican Challenge

For the second year running, eight of the best archers from around the world were invited to compete against the top athletes from the host nation in the heart of its capital, Mexico City.

Featuring stars like Aida ROMAN, Matt STUTZMAN, Mauro NESPOLI and Linda OCHOA, the competition was decided by the last arrow. Drawn on match points at 9-all with just the recurve team contest to go, Mexico fought back from a 4-0 set point deficit to win the 2014 Mexican Challenge when Olympic silver medallist Aida shot a final nine.

#### International Paralympic Committee

The IPC was formed in 1989 to centralise the organisation of multi-disability multisport Games: namely, the Paralympics. Although the Paralympic Games started back at Rome 1960, since the creation of the IPC the event has gone from strength to strength. ### Clean Sport

#### ALPHA by WADA

Until recently, elite athlete anti-doping education centred on event-driven outreach programmes providing "just-in-time" knowledge, yet research and maturity acquired in anti-doping now show that information alone will not prevent doping. WADA has channelled this greater understanding and knowledge into what is known as the Athlete Learning Program about Health & Anti-Doping (ALPHA), a programme launched at the WADA Anti-Doping Organizations Symposium in March.

ALPHA consists of eight sessions and takes two hours to complete. Athletes are encouraged to take the course in several stages. Progress is then saved from one visit to another. A score of 80% or higher is required for ALPHA certification, though athletes with insufficient scores are able to repeat the programme.

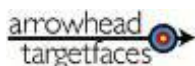
