She also won gold at two consecutive Paralympic Games in London and Rio.

José Almanzor

Professor José Rubén Almanzor Martínez, an Olympian and then successful archery coach, passed away on 10 November 2017 at the age of 87. Almanzor competed at the Munich 1972 Olympic Games, and won a bronze medal at the 1979 Pan American Games in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He was an archery legend in Mexico and in the Americas.

Doping Free

Communication of Sanctions

The Brazilian NADO has sanctioned an archer for an anti-doping rule violation to the World Anti-Doping Code Art. 2.1 (Presence of Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers in an Athlete's Sample). The compound archer Daniel Mesquita Martini (BRA) has been sanctioned by the national anti-doping authority ABCD (Autoridade Brasileira Controle de Dopagem), as follows:

- Disqualification of all prizes, points, medals and results obtained since the competition in which the doping control was given, and in any competitions that have participated after the date of 1 November 2015
- 2 years suspension starting on 1 November 2015
- Anti-doping rule violated according to the World Anti-Doping Code, Art. 2.1: Presence of the prohibited substance Anastrozole (S4. Hormones and Metabolic Modulators) in the athlete's sample

The ISF Gymnasiade, an Olympics for youngsters, will be organised for the first time on the African continent as the 17th edition of the event will be held on 2-9 May 2018 in Marrakech, Morocco, just few months before the Youth Olympics.

This major school sport event organised by International School Sport Federation, whose main motto is "Education through sport", will gather young students from all around the world to experience the spirit of international competition, fair play, friendship and cultural diversity.

South American Games 2022

On 11 December 2017 General Assembly of The South American Sports Organization (ODESUR) held at the Paraguayan Olympic Committee has allocated the 2022 South American Games to the city of Asuncion, capital of Paraguay. Archery has been included in the programme with competitions on 2-5 May.



Pan American Games 2023

On 4 November 2017 in Prague, Czech Republic it was confirmed that Santiago de Chile will host the XIX Panamerican Games in 2023. The Games are planned to be hosted from 6 to 22 October, while the fifth Para Panamerican Games shall run from 3 to 11 November.



Development

Youth Archery

Affiliation

After a rapid but complete process, the World Archery Executive Board awarded the Palau Archery Association a temporary membership Archery just before the 2017 Pacific Mini Games held on 4-15 December 2017 in Vanuatu. The final membership of this association will be submitted to a vote at the 2019 World Archery Congress.

Sri Lanka

Motivated by its recent win of a spot to the 2018 Youth Olympic Games and in its attempts to boost archery in the country, the Sri Lanka Archery Association got the funding from its Ministry of Sport to host a Level 1 Coaching Course. It was conducted from 21 to 28 November 2017 intending to promote archery throughout the island, as there are clubs/coaches in only three of the nine provinces.



Local World Archery Certified Coach Trainer Ranjith Manawadu was supposed to conduct the seminar, but as a health problem imbedded him to do so, he was replaced by World Archery Development and Education Director Pascal Colmaire. Twenty-three participants plus some observers from eight Sri Lankan clubs took part to the course hosted at a Navy Centre in Colombo, where 32 professional archers practice in good conditions.

Sajeevi Silva, Secretary General of Sri Lanka Archery Association, said: "This is one of the goals set out in the SDP discussions. We hope to keep track of their [newly trained coaches] progress and support them with facilities such as equipment for training based on it, so that what they have learnt are worthwhile and the initiative is a sustainable one."

St. Kitts and Nevis

From 25 November to 4 December, World Archery Americas conducted the first developmental mission in the newest member association St. Kitts and Nevis. World Archery Level 1 Coach Trainer Ludys Tejada from the Dominican Republic ran a seminar combining theory with practical sessions.



The President of Saint Kitts and Nevis Archery Association Dane Sandiford said: "I never thought that there were so many details to know in archery; there's lots to learn. Ludys is a great instructor and I am sure that under her guidance we'll do great."
