Athlete fund

The Foundation for Global Sports Development and World Archery have partnered to offer a 150,000 USD fund for international athletes who have lost income due to the COVID-19 pandemic. This money will be distributed as one-time grants of up to 7500 USD. Interested athletes can submit an application via the online form before midnight CET on 31 May 2020.

World Archery's Medical and Sports Science Committee has issued a document of recommendations for post-pandemic archery activities as sport restarts after the peak of the COVID-19 outbreak. Tokyo 2020

Updated processes

Updated qualification procedures for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic and Paralympic Games have been approved by the International Olympic Committee and International Paralympic Committee and released by World Archery. The processes were altered due to the COVID-19 pandemic and one-year delay of the Games. The documents outline the number of available quota places, the events at which they can be obtained, and deadlines in the entry process.

Qualifiers: retain or reselect?

The 87 quota places already awarded for Tokyo are retained by the National Olympic Committees and it also remains the prerogative of the nations to decide who fills each place. As some athletes had already been confirmed for the Games, this has resulted in some difficult situations. Should these archers remain selected? Should new trials be held? Should selections that were in progress be resumed or restarted? There's no simple answer. National teams can update the information provided by contacting the World Archery office.

Recurve 1400

Korea's Ryoo Su Jung has officially become the second recurve archer in history to shoot 1400 points for the 1440 Round (former FITA). The score was recorded at the Korean President's Challenge tournament held in Gwangju in July 2019. It has now been officially recognised and Su Jung will receive an exclusive purple 1400 pin. The only other recurve archer to shoot 1400 is legendary Korean woman Park-Sung Hyun.

Lockdown Knockout for compound

Colombian world number two Sara Lopez beat Norway's reigning World Archery Youth Champion Anders Faugstad to become champion of the Lockdown Knockout, World Archery's first live remote international event. The victory secured Lopez a prize purse of 1000 CHF, which she said she would donate to charities combating the COVID-19 pandemic in Colombia. Anders received 500 CHF for second place. The Lockdown Knockout will return for recurve archers in June.

Lockdown Knockout for recurve

World Archery will return with its successful Lockdown Knockout remote international event in June. Eight world-class recurve archers will be invited to compete from their own homes and ranges. It will begin with a qualification period on 5-8 June with matches following on 13-21 June. The concept was launched in May with a compound competition. It generated more than 4.5 million impressions on social media and record engagement. It was also featured on national television news in countries including Colombia, the Netherlands and Japan.

Former Norwegian archery federation president and World Archery committee chair Per-Erling Bolstad has died aged 78. The news was reported on social media. The long-time face of World Archery's field community served as chair of the discipline's committee from 1991 to 2001. He was also an international judge and attended many world championships.

Margaret Maughan

Great Britain's first Paralympic Champion, archer Margaret Maughan, has died at the age of 91. She made her Paralympic debut at the first Games in Rome in 1960, where she took gold over the Columbia round in the B1 class. Margaret competed in archery, bowls, dartchery and swimming, winning four gold and two silver medals across five Paralympic Games. Her last came in Arnhem in 1980. Her sporting legacy was recognised when she was chosen to light the Paralympic cauldron at London 2012.

Slovenian archer Mihael Kosec has died on 25 May aged 52. He participated in the barebow division at the World Archery Field Championships in Cortina in 2018, where he ranked fifth in the team event. He also participated in three editions of the Indoor Archery World Cup in Nimes between 2016 and 2018, as well as several European events. He was married to Dolores Cekada Kosec, herself also an international archer.

Event Highlights

The international calendar is currently suspended until 31 August. The world ranking lists will remain unchanged until this date.

Restarting national competitions is decided by each national archery federation. World Archery will start recognising again the results for world records, performance awards and Olympic Games minimum qualification scores from 1 June 2020. The requirements are listed in the rulebook and eligible tournaments will have to be registered in World Archery calendar by the member association.
