Americas

World Archery Americas has become the sport's second continental federation to host its general assembly online. Delegates from all 31 nations that are currently affiliated in good standing to the continental federation attended the virtual meeting on 14 November 2020. The Canadian city of Halifax awarded the Pan American Youth and Masters Championships in 2022. Delegates also approved a new six-area strategic development plan for the continent.

Africa

On 8 November 2020, World Archery Africa organised two online calls with their members - one in English and the other in French – with the World Archery office invited to join. It was the first-time calls have been organised for the continent and more than 20 countries participated. Topics included future strategy and event structure, possible hosts and discussion on an approach for postponing the continental general assembly. The president of World Archery Africa also announced plans for a new training facility, possibly in Cairo, Egypt.



Thailand

The National Archery Association of Thailand celebrated its 50th anniversary this year, having been founded in 1970. The organisation joined World Archery in 1971. A ceremony was held at the national training field in the Sports Authority of Thailand complex during the morning of Thursday 12 November. The federation hosts a popular world ranking event annually in March.

High value performance awards

There has been a change in the procedure to claim high value performance awards. Claims arenow submitted through the extranet and email claims are no longer accepted. Team rules

Squads representing companies, clubs or independent groups can compete remotely with a shot at qualifying for this year's team-only Indoor Archery World Series Finals. The ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has resulted in further partial or full lockdowns in many countries. This will make it difficult for teams to shoot the three events that would have contributed to the ranking - so the decision has been made to update the rules and change how the ranking will be decided. Teams will be ranked on only their single best score throughout the season.

Para world championships

The 2021 World Archery Para Championships, due to take place early next year, have been postponed until 18-27 February 2022 as a result of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Dubai will host the 2022 World Archery Para Championships at the Dubai Club for People of Determination. It means that championships for para archers will be held in consecutive years as the following edition, which is scheduled for Pilsen, Czech Republic in 2023 and will act as the primary qualifier for the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games, remains unchanged.

Americas Online Cup

Mexico's Angel Alvarado beat Nicholas D'Amour of the US Virgin Islands to win recurve men's gold, a prize cheque for 200 USD, and the ninth and last title in the Online Archery Cup of the Americas. More than 700 archers participated in the tournament, which began back in August with qualifiers at the national level. The 50 remote matches, which were streamed live on Facebook, reached more than half a million people. At least 3000 USD in prize money was distributed equally across the categories.
