

Thailand

Sanguan Kosavinta has been re-elected as president of the National Archery Association of Thailand for another four-year term, ending in 2024. The unanimous vote was taken at the federation's 2020 congress held on 17 October at the Rajamangala National Stadium in Bangkok. The National Olympic Committee of Thailand and Sports Authority of Thailand were represented by two officials each at the meeting.

World Archery President Prof Dr Ugur Erdener has sent a letter of congratulations to World Archery Asia President Chung Euisun for his appointment as chair of Hyundai Motor Group. Chung Mong-Koo, his father, has been made honorary chair. Chung Euisun has served as president of archery's continental federation in Asia and president of the Korean Archery Association since 2005. Hyundai is the title sponsor of the Archery World Cup and World Archery Championships.

Broadcast

KBS

National broadcaster KBS has extended its exclusive media rights agreement in Korea to cover the Hyundai Archery World Cup and Hyundai World Archery Championships in the new Olympic year of 2021. KBS has held the rights to broadcast international archery events since 2018. Korea has already qualified a full six-athlete quota to the archery competitions at the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games.

Retirement

Five-time Paralympian John Cavanagh his retired. The 64-yearold represented Great Britain from the Sydney 2000 Paralympic Games through to Rio 2016, setting records in 2004 on his way to W1 gold and following that up with a silver medal at Beijing 2008. After competing in five successive Paralympics, he had his heart set on retiring at the conclusion of the Games this summer in Tokyo. But with the upcoming Paralympics now postponed until next year due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and with no sign of his ongoing shoulder injuries letting up, Cavanagh announced earlier this month that he has decided to call time on his career.

Teams

National coach

Former world number one Peter Elzinga is set to join the Dutch archery team's coaching staff, replacing outgoing assistant Emiel Custers. The 39-year-old compound archer was European Champion in 2004, silver medallist at the first Archery World Cup Final in 2006 and was, until recently, an active member of the Netherlands' international squad. Currently the 15th-ranked compound man in the world, Elzinga also said this move would not mark the end of his own archery career.

Korean trials

Korea's national team selection process for 2021 has begun and in some cases already ended, as the compound categories have been announced. Trials for the compound team were held over three days, finishing on Monday 26 October, at the team's national training centre in Yecheon, located one hour south of Seoul. The first and second phases of the traditionally gruelling recurve selection process took place as well, with 20 archers selected for winter squads. It is unclear when the selection process will resume, but it is likely to be in the new year.

Antalya International Challenge

Poland's Lukasz Przybylski and Magdalena Smialkowska claimed their first international podiums as they won the compound men's and recurve women's events, respectively, at the 2020 International Antalya Challenge. Artem Makhnenko of Russia and Andrea Marcos of Spain also collected victories at this first major tournament following the end of the competition hiatus, which was in place from March to September due to the worldwide pandemic. More than 100 archers from 13 countries competed in Antalya.


Entry open

The 18th ISF Gymnasiade - School Summer Games Jinjiang 2020 was postponed from 2020 to 2021 due to the COVID 19 pandemia. Registration will only be possible through the ISF online registration system (ERAS). Athletes you can use the same accounts they used in the past competitive season in order to enter ERAS. In case they do not have an ERAS account yet, they can create one by clicking on the "Access" tab in the upper right corner of the ERAS home page. The first registration phase is open from 30 October 2020.

World Academy of Sport courses

The World Academy of Sport is making two educational programmes available to archers and sports administrators at the end of 2020. For young archers aged between 15 and 18 years, an online certificate teaching the understanding and tools needed to achieve results in elite sport is completely free of charge. Graduates or professionals within federations looking to upskill in sports administration can apply for a scholarship towards a postgraduate certificate run in cooperation with the University of London.
