Obituary

Simon Terry

Three-time Olympian **Simon Terry**, who won two bronze medals at Barcelona 1992, has died in his home at the age of 47, after fighting an aggressive form of cancer. The Brit shot at three Olympics in 1992, 2008 and 2012. [MORE](#)

Kazakhstan's compound archer Pavel Fisher passed away on 11 July at the age of 31, following a car accident and a coma for several days. He competed in four world championships between 2011 and 2017, and a few World Cup stages.

Germany

On 1 May, **Hans-Heinrich von Schönfels** was re-elected as president of the German Shooting and Archery Federation for a new term until 2025.

Japan

On 13 June, **Shinzo Abe** was re-elected as president and **Goro Okano** elected as new secretary general of the Japan archery federation for terms running until 2023.

Luxembourg

Tun Schlechter is the new president of the Luxembourg archery federation as of 1 April and **Isabel Dias** remains as the general secretary, both with terms running until end 2022.

Continental ranking lists

Official rankings for each of archery's five continents are now being published alongside the world rankings on the World Archery website and will be issued every two weeks and after major international events. Continental rankings have been backdated as far back as 2007. [MORE](#)

World records

Sawyer Sullivan beat the under-18 (cadet) compound men's world record for the 72-arrow 50-metre round twice in two days, with 708 and 714 points at the USA's youth nationals. Both scores are higher than the former record of 706 by Croatian archer Mario Vavro at the senior World Archery Championships in 2013. [MORE](#)

Travel to Yankton

It is possible to get special support letters (National Interest Exemption) for teams who want to participate in the Yankton 2021 Hyundai World Archery Championships or Congress. This is helpful for countries who are currently on USA travel ban list, in order to be able to proceed with normal ESTA or visa applications. More

Mexican Grand Prix

The world ranking and para world ranking event, also a continental qualifier for the World Games, meant to be held in Monterrey, Mexico in November 2021, has been cancelled. More information on new dates and possible reallocation will be provided as soon as available.

Commonwealth Championships

The planned Commonwealth Archery and Shooting Championships, due to take place in the Indian city of Chandigarh in early 2022, has been cancelled due to the ongoing pandemic uncertainties. [MORE](#)

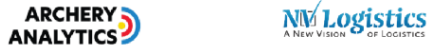
