### World Archery Asia

**Chung Euisun** has been re-elected as president of World Archery Asia at its biennial congress in Dhaka, Bangladesh. He has served in the position since 2005. [MORE](#)

### World Archery Europe

The executive board meeting of World Archery Europe took place on 6-7 November in the German archery federation's headquarters and new training centre in Wiesbaden. Decisions included nomination of technical delegates for major continental competitions and allocation of events for 2023. [MORE](#)

### Turkey

**Abdullah Topaloglu** has been re-elected as president and **Sirer Aydin** re-appointed as secretary general of the Turkish archery federation for terms until October 2024.

### Membership application

The **Palestine archery federation** and **Timor Leste archery federation** have submitted a membership application as per Rule 1.5.1. According to Article 1.5.2, member associations and executive board members have 60 days (until 17 January 2022) to raise any objections to this request in writing to World Archery office. Without serious opposition, a temporary affiliation will be granted, and the final membership submitted to a vote at World Archery Congress in 2023.

## IOC

### Transition seminar

On 10 November, the International Olympic Committee held a seminar for international federations reviewing the Games in Tokyo and looking towards Paris. World Archery, along with the other international federations, received an Olympic torch from president Thomas Bach, which will be displayed in the World Archery Excellence Centre in Lausanne.

## Events

### Indoor World Series

The Indoor Archery World Series returns in 2022 and will be open to tournaments at local level. For the first time, any world record status event can join the circuit and results will count towards the open ranking. The traditional major stages in Nimes and Las Vegas will count towards the elite ranking and qualify archers for the Indoor Archery World Series Finals. There will be no team competition in 2022. ### Kansai 2021

The World Masters Games, which were to be held in Japan in 2021 and were first postponed to May 2022, have been delayed again until further notice, most likely not before 2024. The World Archery Executive Board will assess the impact on the World Archery Masters Championships.

### Tampere 2023

Outdoor and field archery will be included in the programme of the European Masters Games to be held from 25 June to 1 July 2023 in Finland.

### Birmingham 2022

The USA, El Salvador, Colombia and Puerto Rico won quota places for the Birmingham 2022 World

Games at the Americas' continental qualification event in Medellin, Colombia. The new six quotas bring the total awarded to 38, with 18 remaining at the last continental qualifier in Asia and to the top archers on the world ranking list not yet qualified at the end of this year. [MORE](#)
