Elections

APSO board

Secretary general **Tom Dielen** has been reelected to the executive board of the Association of Paralympic Sports Organisations during its general assembly on 10 December. He has served as vice president since 2017. **MORE**

World Archery Africa

Ahmed Tarik Amiry of Sudan was elected president of World Archery Africa for a three-year term during an online exceptional assembly on Friday 17 December. He takes over from Egypt's Aladin Gabr, who had held the position since 2010. MORE

World Archery Asia

Honorary vice president **Sanguan Kosavinta** was re-elected as executive board member of the National Olympic Committee of Thailand for a 10th term on 1 November.

Egypt

Aladin Gabr was re-elected as president and **Ahmed Sameh** as secretary general of the Egyptian archery federation on 7 November for terms until 2024.

Oatar

Meshaal Ebrahim Al-Nasr was elected as president and **Ishaq Murtada Al-Hashemi** as secretary general of the Qatar archery federation on 6 December for terms until 2024.

Romania

Cornel Milan was elected as new president and **Ion Pandele** re-elected as secretary general of the Romanian archery federation on 26 November for terms until 2025.

Saudi Arabia

Mushal Alhokair was elected president on 6 September and **Abdulrahman Alshudukhi** appointed secretary general in November for terms until 2024.

South Africa

Patrick Roux was elected as new president of the South African archery federation and **Barbara Manning** re-elected as secretary general on 13 November for terms until 2024.











Awards

Colombia

Reigning world champion **Sara Lopez** was named Colombia's best non-Olympic athlete of 2021 at an award ceremony in Bogota on 15 December. She is the first archer to receive the award. **MORE**

El Salvador

Reigning Pan American Games Champion

Roberto Hernandez was named best archer but also El Salvador's coach of the year at the Espiga Dorada awards. He was responsible for the youth team that collected two bronze medals at the Junior Pan American Games. MORE

India

Paralympic bronze medallist **Harvinder Singh** has become the first para archer to be recognised with the Arjuna Award. He was one of 35 athletes to receive India's highest annual honour for sportspeople in 2021. **MORE**

Turkey

Olympic Champion **Mete Gazoz** was named athlete of the year by Turkey's *GQ* magazine at its annual Men of the Year ceremony in Istanbul on 17 December. **MORE**

Events

Paris 2024

Archery will award nine gold medals at the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games with the programme of events unchanged from those featured at Rio 2016 and Tokyo 2020. It is yet to be announced

whether the number or distribution of quota places will be changed or not. **MORE**

Los Angeles 2028

Archery is on the list of the initial 28 sports proposed by the International Olympic Committee's executive board for inclusion at the LA28 Olympic Games. The specific disciplines, events and athlete quota for all sports will not be decided until late 2024. MORE

Emma Gaptchenko

Emma Gaptchenko, the 1971 World Archery Champion and 1972 Olympic bronze medallist, died on 6 December 2021 at the age of 83. She was the first Soviet archer to podium at the Olympics. MORE
