Keto Losaberidze

Georgia's most decorated Olympic archer, Ketevan Losaberidze, died on Sunday 23 January 2022 at the age of 73. Keto won gold at the Moscow 1980 Olympics representing the Soviet Union and was the founding president of the Georgian archery federation in 2002. MORE
