Board meeting

The end-of-year executive board meeting took place on 16-17 December in Belek, Türkiye. MORE

Headline decisions:

- 2024 World Archery Field Championships awarded to Lac La Biche, Canada
- 2024 Hyundai Archery World Cup stages awarded to China, Korea and Türkiye
- 2025-2027 Hyundai Archery World Cup stages awarded to USA, China, Türkiye and Spain
- Approval of financial plan for 2023-2035
- Approval of eight bylaws that will come into effect on 1 March 2023
- Approval of transgender eligibility policy principles

Decisions were introduced to member associations during on 19 December online call.

Members

Mexico

The Mexican archery federation has been **derecognised** as a member association following the outcome of a judicial case against former president Efi Sanchez. Athletes will still compete while transition committees are in place and a new association created. MORE

Belarus

Mikalai Marusau and Siarhei Shchamialiou were elected as new president and new secretary general of the Belarus archery federation, until 2025.

Chinese Taipei

Lin Hong Dow and Lin Cheng-Hsien were elected as new president and secretary general of the archery association of Chinese Taipei, until 2026.

Denmark

Kenn Romme was elected as new secretary general of the Danish archery association, until 2024.

Finland

Mika Savola took up the position of president of the Finnish archery association upon resignation of former leadership, until new elections are held in April 2023.

Hong Kong, China

Lau Kun Hung Terry was re-elected as president of the archery association of Hong Kong for a third full-term until 2024. Hung Hing Chiu Simon was elected as new secretary general, until 2024.

Kyrgyzstan

Elnura Osmonalieva and Azamat Kaldybaev were re-elected as president and secretary general of the Kyrgyz archery federation for a second full-term until 2026.









Slovakia

Vladimir Buzek was re-elected as president of the Slovak archery association, until 2026.

Uganda

Richard McBond Asiimwe and Robert Zavuga

were re-elected as president and secretary general of the Uganda archery federation for a second full-term until 2026.

Olympic Solidarity

These **coaching courses** were held in the second half of 2022 with OS support:

- 19-26 September (Ecuador): Level 2
- 20-28 October (Georgia): Level 2
- 20-28 November (Nigeria): Level 1
- 20 Nov-5 Dec (Israel): Level 2, 3
- 30 Nov- 6 Dec (Sierra Leone): Level 1

The courses were conducted by eight World Archery expert coach trainers and counted near 700 hours of training, benefiting a total of 49 women and 145 men coaches.

Member associations are encouraged to approach their National Olympic Committees to request support from Olympic Solidarity programmes. PAISAC general coaching education in Montreal, Canada, and Lausanne, Switzerland, for African members can be also funded by OS.
