

Continental youth training camp - Medellin, Colombia 25 September to 2 October 2023

World Archery and World Archery Americas are pleased to announce the implementation of a continental training camp to take place in Medellin, Colombia on 25 September (arrivals) – 2 October (departures).

The purpose of the training camp is to enhance the technical and competitive level of young archers (born in 2000 or after) who prepare for upcoming continental and international events. Athletes and coaches will also take part of seminars on different topics.

Programme

	Afternoon session: one to one session / sequence + video analysis with coaches
29 September	Morning session: tuning + free shooting
	Afternoon session: tuning + antidoping and safeguarding
30 September	Morning session: tuning – free shooting
	Afternoon session: tuning + technical form
1 October	72 arrows + match play simulation
	Camp closing
2 October	Departures

Experts

Two international coaches with vast experience have been chosen to run the camp in English and Spanish:

- World medallist <u>Filippo Clini</u> (ITA)
- World medallist and Olympian <u>Juan Rene Serrano</u> (MEX)

Eligibility for Olympic Solidarity funding

The following criteria applies to participants who want to benefit from Olympic Solidarity funding:

- **Maximum of three people** by eligible member association (one female athlete + one male athlete + one coach)
- **Age limit** for this programme is 23 years old (born in 2000 or later)
- **Minimum qualification score** per gender (70 meter round, 72 arrows):
 - o 580 for men
 - o 550 for women

Archery facility

The training camp will be held at the South American Archery Range in Medellin, a permanent archery facility which has housed major international events including two stages of the Hyundai Archery World Cup in 2022 and 2023.

Accommodation and meals

Accommodation will be provided at the Casa Rosales Hotel, located at Carrera 68, No. 32E-27, Medellin, at a walking distance from the archery facility.





Participants will be accommodated in double and triple rooms. In most cases it will be necessary to share rooms with participants from other countries.

Breakfast and dinner will be provided at the hotel. Lunch will be served at the archery facility.
