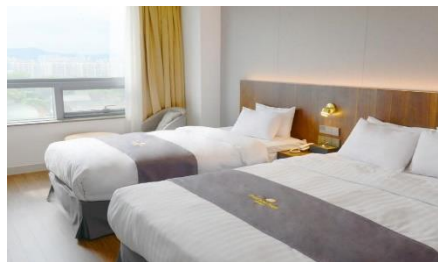
Eligibility for Olympic Solidarity funding

The following criteria applies to participants who want to benefit from Olympic Solidarity funding:

- **Maximum of three people** by eligible member association (one female athlete + one male athlete + one coach)
- **Age limit** for this programme is 23 years old (born in 2000 or later)
- **Minimum qualification score** per gender (70 meter round, 72 arrows):
 - 580 for men
 - 550 for women

Accommodation, meals and local transport

All participants must stay at the official hotel - Inter-Burgo Wonju (TBC).

Meals and local transportation will be covered by World Archery Asia and LOC

Additional information and contact person

All participants who need an entry visa to Korea will be required to complete the Visa Support Letter section in WAREOS by no later than **21 July 2023**.

The applicants are responsible for supplying the necessary information, and ensuring all details are up to date, correct, and submitted by the deadlines specified. In addition, all participants that require a visa are kindly requested to supply a copy of their latest/valid passport. Copies of each application can be uploaded on WAREOS. All passport copies and personal details entered/uploaded to WAREOS will be held securely and in the strictest confidence and not shared with other parties.

All participants must have a valid World Archery license and will be covered by travel and health insurance.
