

General description: This is a course covering intermediate coaching skills, including advanced technique training, equipment study and tuning, and the theory of biomechanics and psychology in archery.

Objective: To be able to improve the archer's standard in some specialties – usually one equipment division and one or two archery disciplines. To work with adult, young and disabled archers.

Diploma: Participants receive a diploma of attendance.

Services and options available during the course:

- Outdoor Range (50m, 70m on request, and any other distances needed if available)
- Indoor Hall (18m, 50m and 70m, and other distances if available)
- Archery equipment storage
- · Equipment repair booth
- Shooting form video analysis system (video with delayed replay from four different angles) if available
- Fitness and sauna on request

Requirements:

- World Archery Level 1 coaching <u>certification</u> not older than 2017
- World Archery Level 1 coaching <u>online course</u> for candidates with national/other international certification + 1 year of experience
- Anti-doping online course for high performance coaches
- A support letter from the national federation
- World Archery advises its member associations to register coaches with at least one year of experience as Level 1 Coach (with national or international certification)

Payment conditions: by bank wire/transfer to the WAEC bank account. Payment details will be communicated in a later stage. Refundable only if cancelled no later than 20 days before the course.
