



General description: This is a course covering advanced coaching skills to assist elite athletes and to develop a national high performance programme.

Objectives:

- to train and develop specific skills of the archer over a determined period of time to reach a high competitive level in one division and one or two discipline(s)
- to structure and manage high performance

Diploma: Participants receive a diploma of attendance

World Archery educational supports:

- Guide to establish a performance archery plan
- Training plan samples
- One year of weekly training tips
