## **BYLAW**

## Approved by FITA Council on 10 November 2007 Effective as of 1 April 2008

## **Book 1, Article 3.23.1**

- *3.23.1.1 The following items for the athlete will be allowed:* 
  - Two bows;
  - One spotting scope and tripod;
  - Arrows and one target archery quiver;
  - Accessories as listed in Book 2, Article 7.3.
- 3.23.1.2 The following items for the <u>team official</u> will be allowed:
  - One belt pack to carry archery accessories for the athlete or team;
  - One pair of binoculars or spotting scope with tripod.
- 3.23.1.3 In case of inclement weather, necessary protection, in addition to clohting, may be used according to approval by the Technical Delegate (or, in his or her absence, the Chairman of the Tournament Judges Commission) of the event.
- 3.23.1.4 During the Finals of the Olympic Games and World Target Outdoor and Indoor Men's and Women's Championships, telescopes must be adjusted so the highest portion of the scope is no higher than the top of the shoulder of the athlete.
