7.2.5.16 A score board or some other such device with the athlete's name and/or target number (1A, 1B, lC or simply A, B, C and adding D if there are four athletes per target butt, etc.) may replace the name plate and the flip score device for displaying progressive total scores. When this device is being used, it will be placed on the ground below each butt. It must be pegged or fixed securely to prevent movement by wind. It will be changed by the appointed scorer, aided by the athletes on that target butt, after the arrows have been scored and drawn, and before they leave the target butt.
