Book 2, Article 7.4.2.3 :

7.4.2.3 An arrow shot on the competition field after the DOS has officially closed the practice session (which is after the pulling of the practice arrows); or during the breaks between distances or rounds, will be considered part of the next scoring end. It will cause the athlete to lose the highest scoring arrow of the next scoring end, which will be scored as a miss.
