Book 3, Article 8.5.5.2 (replace)

8.5.5.2 When there is match play alternate shooting athletes competing will go to the shooting line upon the 10 sec. alerting signal. At the end of the 10 seconds one sound signal will start the 30-second shooting period for the first athlete in the match. As soon as the first arrow is shot and the score is posted, the countdown clock for the opponent athlete is started to indicate his or her 30 second period to shoot one arrow. The athletes of the match will continue to alternate their shots following the countdown clock visual signal until each athlete has shot his or her three arrows.
