Book 3, Article 8.6.4.1 (replace):

8.6.4.1 In tournaments where there are no official scorers and the athletes score themselves, the signing of the score card also denotes that the athlete agrees with the sum total (identical on both score cards), the number of 10's and the number of 9's. Should a discrepancy be found in the sum total, the sum total of the lowest arrow scores will become final.

The organisers are not obligated to accept or record scorecards that are submitted without signatures, the total sum, the number of 10's and the number of 9's.
