9.8.2.2 A Judge, timing an athlete and observing him exceed the <u>3</u>-minute time limit, will caution him <u>verbally and confirm this warning</u> by a signed note on the scorecard, indicating the time of the warning. At the second and all subsequent warnings during that stage of the competition, the athlete's highest scoring arrow at the target will be forfeited (9.5.1.12).
