Effective as of 1 April 2011

7.6.5.2.3 Teams:

- A 3-arrow (2-arrow for mixed team) shoot-off for score, a single arrow by each team member (~~maximum of 3 shoot-offs~~);
- If the score is still tied ~~in the third shoot-off~~, the team with the arrow closest-to-the-centre will win;
- If still tied the arrow second (~~or third~~) closest-to-the-centre will determine the winner;
- ~~If still tied the arrow third closest to the centre will determine the winner;~~
- ~~If necessary there will be successive shoot offs for score, if necessary followed by closest to the centre evaluation until the tie is resolved;~~
- In alternate shooting, the team that shot first in the match will start shooting the shoot-off;
- In alternate shooting, the alternation between the teams will take place after every shot arrow ~~each of the team members has shot 1 arrow~~;
- For the Team Compound Match Round the shoot-off will be shot on a single target face.
