7.6.5.2.3 Teams:

- A 3-arrow (2-arrow for mixed team) shoot-off for score, a single arrow by each team member (maximum of 3 shoot-offs):
- If the score is still tied in the third shoot off, the team with the arrow closest-to-the-centre will win;
- If still tied the arrow second (or third) closest-to-the-centre will determine the winner;
- If still tied the arrow third closest-to-the-centre will determine the winner;
- If necessary there will be successive shoot-offs for score, if necessary followed by closest to the centre evaluation until the tie is resolved;
- In alternate shooting, the team that shot first in the match will start shooting the shoot-off;
- In alternate shooting, the alternation between the teams will take place after every shot arrow each of the team members has shot 1 arrow;
- For the Team Compound Match Round the shoot-off will be shot on a single target face.

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
