7.6.5.2.4 For the Compound Match Round

• ...

• If still tied after 3 shoot offs the highest ranked athlete (team) wins. If the score is still tied in the third shoot-off, the athlete (team) with the arrow closest-to-the-centre will win; If still tied the arrow second closest-to-the-centre will determine the winner; If necessary there will be successive shoot-offs for score, if necessary followed by closest-to-the-centre evaluation until the tie is resolved.
