## **BYLAW**

## Approved by FITA Council on 14 November 2010 Effective as of 1 January 2011

## Book 3, Article 8.6.5.2.2

- 8.6.5.2.2 *Team (match play):* 
  - A 3-arrow shoot-off for score, a single arrow by each team member (maximum of 3 shoot-offs);
  - If the score is still tied in the third shoot-off, the team with the arrow closest-to-the-centre will win;
  - If still tied the arrow second (<u>or third</u>) closest-to-the-centre arrow will determine the winner;
  - If necessary there will be successive shoot-offs for score, if necessary followed by 3closest to the centre evaluation until the tie is resolved; In alternate shooting, the team that shot first in the match will start shooting the shoot-off;
  - In alternate shooting, the alternation between the teams will take place after <u>every shot arrow</u> each of the team members has shot 1 arrow.
