- 9.1.4 Pass a renewal evaluation run by the Judges' Committee. The evaluation consists of 2 three parts:
 - A written open-book test to be taken in the last year second half of the accreditation period and at least 60 days year before the accreditation expires. This part is aimed to verify that the judge has up-to-date knowledge of the FITA Rules and that the judge is able to enforce them in real situations and according to the Judges' Committee approved procedures;
 - The analysis of the reports by the chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commissions where the judge was on duty and by the Judge Observer when present; this part is aimed to verify the actual performance of the judge in competition.
 - <u>A written timed close-book test to be taken at the first</u> <u>conference of participation within the accreditation period.</u> <u>This part is aimed to verify that the judges has an ability to</u> <u>handle stress situations in line with the rules and established</u> <u>judging procedures.</u>
