

**BYLAW**

**Approved by FITA Council on 17 December 2011**  
**Effective as of 1 April 2012**

**Book 1, Article 3.7.4.3**

- 3.7.4.3 *A forfeited match is a match in which one of the 2 athletes/teams is not present when the order of shooting is decided (when shooting alternately) or in which 1 athlete/team ~~has not shot any arrows at the end of the first end/set~~ is not present at the start of the match (both athletes/teams shooting at the same time). The athlete/team ~~not~~ present when the order of shooting is decided or ~~not shooting the first end~~ present at the start of the match will be declared the ~~loser~~ winner of that match.*
