## **Book 2, Article 7.7.2.5**

7.7.2.5 An athlete arriving after shooting has started will forfeit the number of arrows already shot, unless the <u>Chair of Tournament Judges Commission</u>, or his designee, <u>Director of Shooting</u> is satisfied that the athlete was delayed by circumstances beyond his control. In this case the athlete will be allowed to make up the lost arrows after the distance then being shot is completed, but in no circumstances may that be more than 12 arrows. It is not possible for an athlete to make up arrows in the Olympic or Compound Match Round.
