- 7.8.1.8.2 Anyone who alters without authorization, or falsifies, a score, or knowingly has a score altered or falsified, shall be disqualified.
- 7.8.1.8.3 Arrows withdrawn from the target prior to the scores being confirmed by the scorers shall score a miss (M) and a repeated offence shall result in the athlete being disqualified.
