11.10.4.1 ~~Each athlete will shoot separately and~~ In Field and 3D rounds the athlete can stand or kneel up to approximately 1m in any direction beside or behind at the shooting peg, taking into consideration the condition of the terrain. In exceptional circumstances a Judge may give permission to shoot from outside the defined area, without compromising safety. When shooting, the athlete must, however, touch the peg with a portion of his body (this touching can be from the rear, front or sides of the shooting peg). In Field and 3D rounds every shooting position will have a shooting peg or mark to accommodate at least 2 athletes.
