6. Change Requested or Question:	Modify article 8.5.1 8.5.1 The candidates are subject to the World Archery Reaccreditation procedure, except for IJC who are first accredited in the year in which a reaccreditation process is conducted.
7. Reason(s):	The Judges' Committee feels that IJC who are first accredited in the year in which the accreditation process is being conducted should not be subject to this process because, for obvious reasons, they cannot be expected to comply with the requisites laid out in articles 10.1.1; 10.1.2; and 10.1.5. When they apply to attend the IJC seminar they are complying with article 10.1.3. Article 10.1.4 is complied with when they pass a closed-book exam in the same year in which the judges going through the reaccreditation process take an open-book test.
