8.1.1.8.2 At no point may any target face be less than 15cm from the ground.
8.1.1.8.3 In all instances, regardless of the terrain, the buttress should be placed perpendicular to the athlete's line of sight from the shooting peg in order to present the target face's full picture.
8.1.1.8.4 At all times the full scoring zone shall be visible from a height of 150cm.

7. Reason(s):	Following an appeal at The World Games regarding the visibility of a target face from the shooting peg. When the rule was reviewed by the jury it became apparent that 8.1.1.8 referred to the perpendicular visibility of the face rather than the face in general. Therefore the rule has been reviewed to make it clearer and ensure that the spirit of the rule is not lost.
C&R comment:	Article 8.1.1.8 must be added with text:
