**Response from the Medical Committee:**

It is the official opinion of the FITA Medical Committee that FITA policy regarding the participation in archery events of individuals who have undergone sex reassignment is to comply with the “Stockholm consensus on sex reassignment in sports” approved by the IOC Executive Board on 17 May 2004 upon recommendation of the Ad-Hoc Committee convened by the IOC Medical Commission in October 2003.
