INTERPRETATIONS

WORLD ARCHERY CONSTITUTION AND RULES

Book 3, Chapter 11, Article 11.1.7.1

The Barbados Archery Association has requested an interpretation as to whether arrows must be numbered and, in international competition, have the three letter country code, i.e. BAR for Barbados, on the shaft.

The Constitution and Rules Committee ("C&R") finds the question presented to be within the terms of reference of the Judges Committee.

C&R has determined that the following interpretation is not contrary to the existing rules or Congress decisions.

Response from the Judges Committee:

The arrow shafts shall be marked with the athlete's name or initials. No additional markings are required.
