

INTERPRETATIONS
WORLD ARCHERY CONSTITUTION AND RULES

Book 4, Article 22.3.6.2

The Russian Archery Federation has requested an interpretation as to whether the weights as depicted below are allowed on a barebow.

The Constitution and Rules Committee (“C&R”) finds the question presented to be within the terms of reference of the Technical Committee after consultation with the Field and 3D Archery Committee.

C&R has determined that the following interpretation is not contrary to the existing rules or Congress decisions.

Response from the Technical Committee:

It is the opinion of the Technical Committee that the weights depicted in the pictures below are permitted to be attached to a barebow since the bow with the weights appears to fit in a 12.2 cm ring, and otherwise complies with the requirements of Article 22.3.6.2. For purposes of this interpretation, the weight is assumed not to contain a shock absorbing device.
